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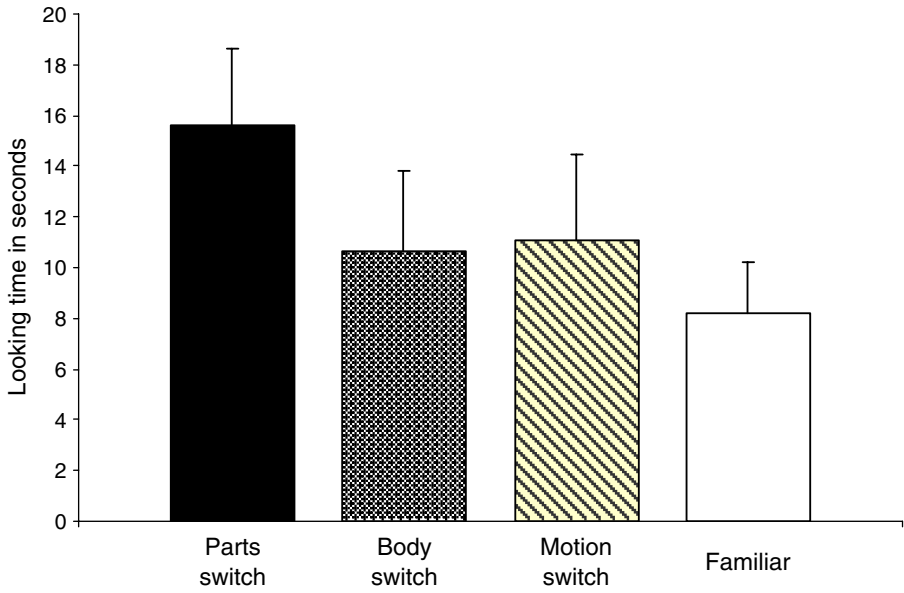


Fig. 3 Looking time to the four test trials in Experiment 1

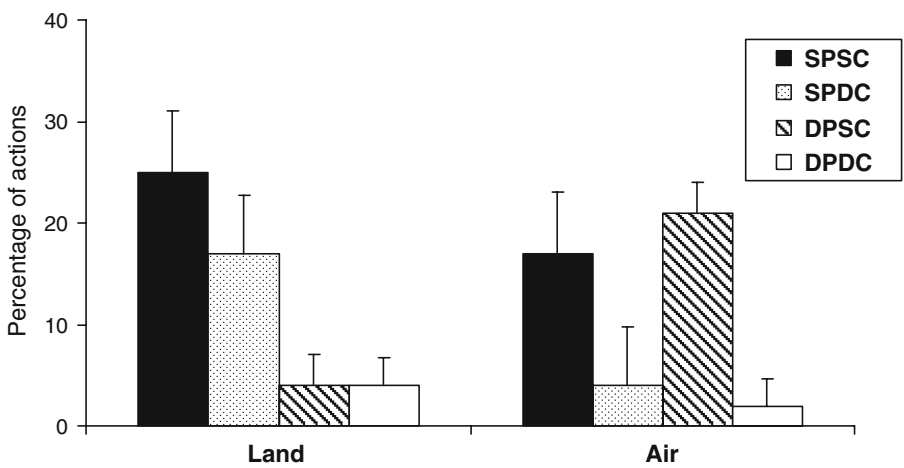


Fig. 4 Land and air motions performed during generalization in Experiment 2
