International Conference on Number Theory dedicated to the 70th birthdays of Professors Antanas Laurinčikas and Eugenijus Manstavičius was held in Palanga (Lithuania), September 9–15, 2018. This significant event was organized by the Faculty of Mathematics and Informatics of Vilnius University, Šiauliai University, and the Lithuanian Mathematical Society to honor two outstanding Lithuanian mathematicians. The participants of the conference representing 13 countries (Austria, Belarus, Germany, Hungary, Ireland, Japan, Lithuania, Poland, Russia, Sweden, Thailand, Turkey, and the UK) delivered 54 talks on various aspects of number theory (zeta functions, arithmetic functions, probabilistic number theory, Diophantine approximation, etc.). The proceedings of the conference are now published as an issue of the *Lithuanian Mathematical Journal*. They contain the papers submitted to the Journal by participants of the conference and selected by editors after a careful reviewing process.
