



## Addendum to “Subjunctive conditionals’ local contexts”

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Mandelkern and Romoli (2017) demonstrate that the local context for a variably strict conditional’s antecedent is the tautology (see footnote 33 in Sect. 4.3.1 of that paper). While the focus of Mandelkern and Romoli’s discussion is the indicative conditional rather than the subjunctive, this particular proof does not depend on specific features of the indicative. It is thus equivalent to the part of the result in my Sect. 3 that concerns the variably strict theory. My result was developed independently prior to seeing their work, and my first journal submission was made prior to the publication of their paper. I regret the error in omitting this citation from the published version.
