The Duncan Black Prize is awarded jointly to Abhinay Muthoo (University of Warwick) and Kenneth A. Shepsle (Harvard University) for:

Information, institutions and constitutional arrangements, *Public Choice*, 144(1–2), 1–36

The Gordon Tullock Prize is awarded to Daniel J. D'Amico (Loyola University New Orleans) for:

The prison in economics: private and public incarceration in Ancient Greece, *Public Choice*, 145(3–4), 461–482
