This abstract of this article was updated to correct the following sentence to read: ICH was detected in 22 patients (13.5%) with no statistical difference between the groups (11.2 vs. 19.1% without and with SARS-CoV-2, respectively, $p=0.21$). Propensity score matching confirmed similar rates of ICH in both groups (12.8 vs. 19.1% without and with SARS-CoV-2, respectively, $p = 0.57$), thus leveling out possible confounders.
