In the previously published “A Call to Action for Mycetoma,” the title did not accurately reflect the content scope. Therefore, the title should read as “Pressing Priorities for Mycetoma Control and Prevention” (as shown above).

The inaccurate title appeared in the original version of this article that was published in *Current Fungal Infection Reports*, Volume 12, Issue 3 (September 2018).

On page 6, line 81, the text reads “now is the time to mobilize these findings,” but should be replaced with “the foundation has been laid to [...].” On line 86, “Now is the time to address” should be replaced with “Based on the evidence [cite refs 1, 3, 6], now is the time to consider addressing...” On line 92, the words “the disease being” are not accurate; the sentence should read: “As recently as 2013, global interest in mycetoma was minimal, familiar only to those who suffered...”

On page 7, a production error did not indent the bullets as requested.

On page 9, line 259, the header reads “A Call to Action,” but should be replaced with “Priorities for Action.” Lines 275–277 contain the error “We therefore make this call to action for a global Mycetoma Action Network dedicated to the prevention and treatment of mycetoma.” This should be corrected as “Therefore, we submit that the creation of a global ‘Mycetoma Action Network’ could contribute to increased understanding of and action to prevent and treat the disease.” On line 305, a citation should be added supporting mycetoma as an NTD and proxy for poverty:

On line 208, the text reads “this call to action,” but should be written as “this statement.”
