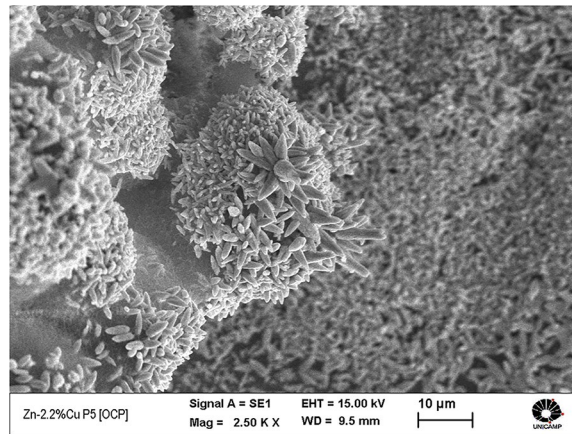


MicroArt
