




Editorial

The journal has had difficulties with EVISE as its manuscript submissions and management platform due to login difficulties, the instability of the server and ease of use. As a result of this it was decided to change to Editorial Manager as the manuscript submission and management platform. It is a well-established and used platform which is stable and very easy to navigate.

Migration began on June 26 and was completed on the beginning of August. All the new and revised submissions were migrated. Manuscripts in the review phase in EVISE will remain there until a decision is made, and then the revision will be submitted to Editorial Manager. It is estimated that the journal will be completely migrated in 2-3 months. I would like to express my appreciation to the authors and reviewers for their patience of during the migration process.

Since the NLM decision for PubMed status for the journal was made, there has been an increase in the number of submissions to *Spine Deformity*. To date we have received twice the number of submissions compared to last year. This will result in consistent 80 page issues, and soon an increase in the number of issues / year from the current bimonthly status.

These are two positive changes and our journal will continue to grow and increase its status as THE place for spine deformity articles.
