Psoriasis	Corneodesmosin (CDSN)	A study in mice suggests that targeting CDSN could help treat psoriasis. CDSN-deficient mice showed aberrant detachment of the upper skin layers compared with those of wild-type mice, and they died several hours after birth. Immunodeficient mice engrafted with CDSN-deficient skin developed psoriasis-like graft phenotypes compared with those of mice engrafted with skin from wild-type mice. Next steps include performing gain-of-function genetic studies with functional analysis to elucidate the link between psoriasis and CDSN mutations.
