

SEM BUILDING FUND: STATUS REPORT

In 1985, SEM purchased an office condominium for its national headquarters operations. In order to retire the mortgage debt over a five-year period, thus saving substantial interest payments, the Society established a Building Fund and solicited donations from its corporate and individual members.

More than 400 donations were received, for a total of \$12,941.30 by the end of 1986. This is short of the goal of

\$33,000 set for 1986, but is a good beginning for the five-year plan. The Building Fund will be continued in 1987 and donations are welcome.
