9th INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE ON EXPERIMENTAL MECHANICS

The following scenes are from the 9th International Conference on Experimental Mechanics held in Lyngby, Denmark, August 20-24, 1990, which was co-sponsored by SEM.

The conference is organized every fourth year by the Permanent Committee for Stress Analysis (PCSA) which just officially changed its name to "European Permanent Committee for Experimental Mechanics."

Twenty-eight countries contributed 236 technical papers. SEM members presented 23 papers and members of the Japanese Society of Mechanical Engineers presented 45--the highest of any organization. Overall attendance exceeded 300 and is believed to be the largest conference in PCSA's history.
