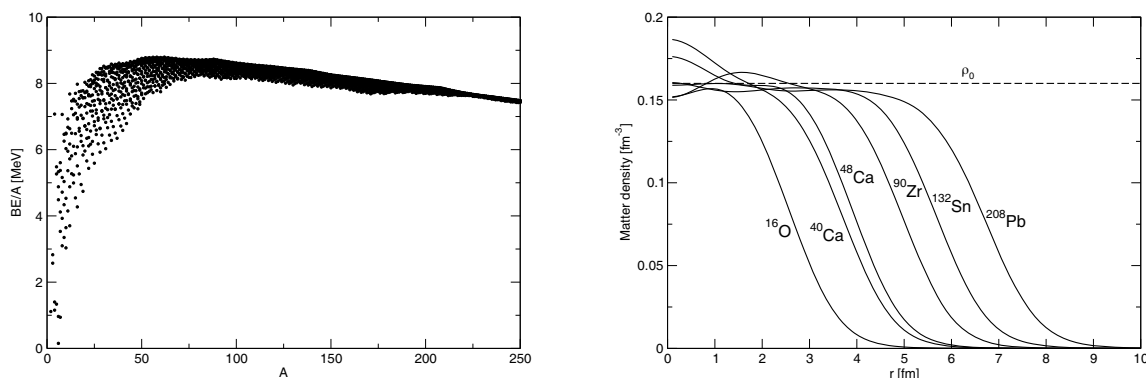


Fig. 2. (Left panel) Binding energy per particle B/A as a function of the mass number A (data from refs. [1,2]). (Right panel) Nuclear matter density for few nuclei. The horizontal line marks the saturation density.

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Due to an error during the publication procedure (in the proof-reading phase), fig. 2 of the paper is different from what it should. The correct figure is as follows.
