



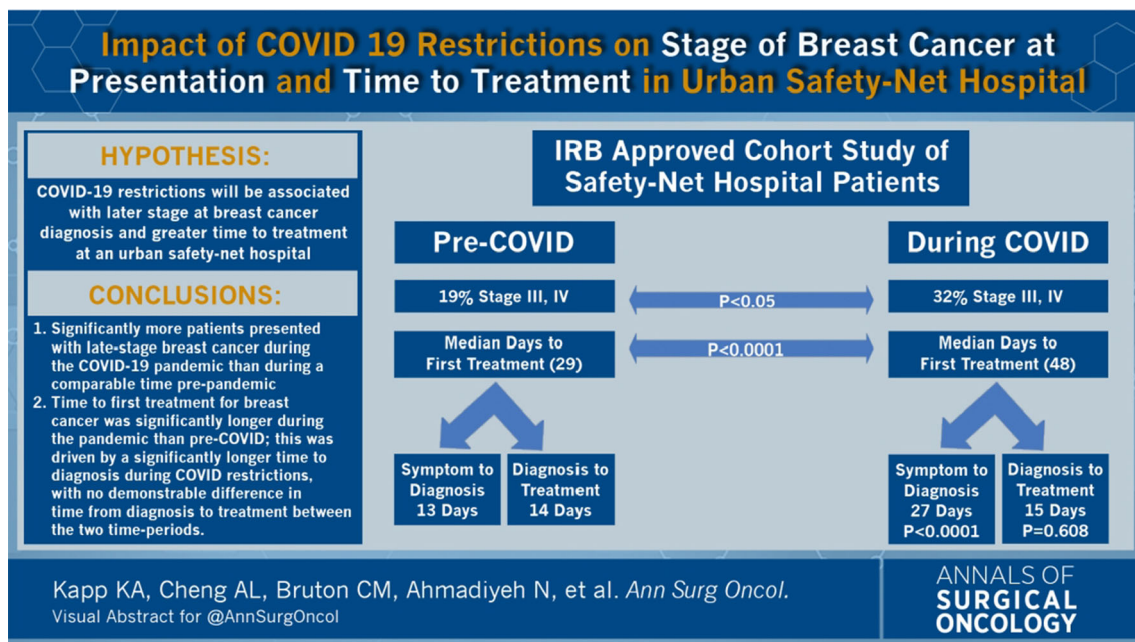
ASO Visual Abstract: Impact of COVID-19 Restrictions on Stage of Breast Cancer at Presentation and Time to Treatment at an Urban Safety-Net Hospital

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This single-institution cohort study of safety-net patients with a new diagnosis of breast cancer aimed to determine the effect of the pandemic on disease stage and time to treatment. During the pandemic, breast cancer was
