

## ASO Visual Abstract: Racial Segregation Among Patients with Cholangiocarcinoma: Impact on Diagnosis, Treatment, and Outcomes

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The role of racial segregation relative to cholangiocarcinoma diagnosis, treatment and outcomes is not known. Racial segregation, as a proxy for structural racism, had a marked effect on Black-white disparities among patients with cholangiocarcinoma.
