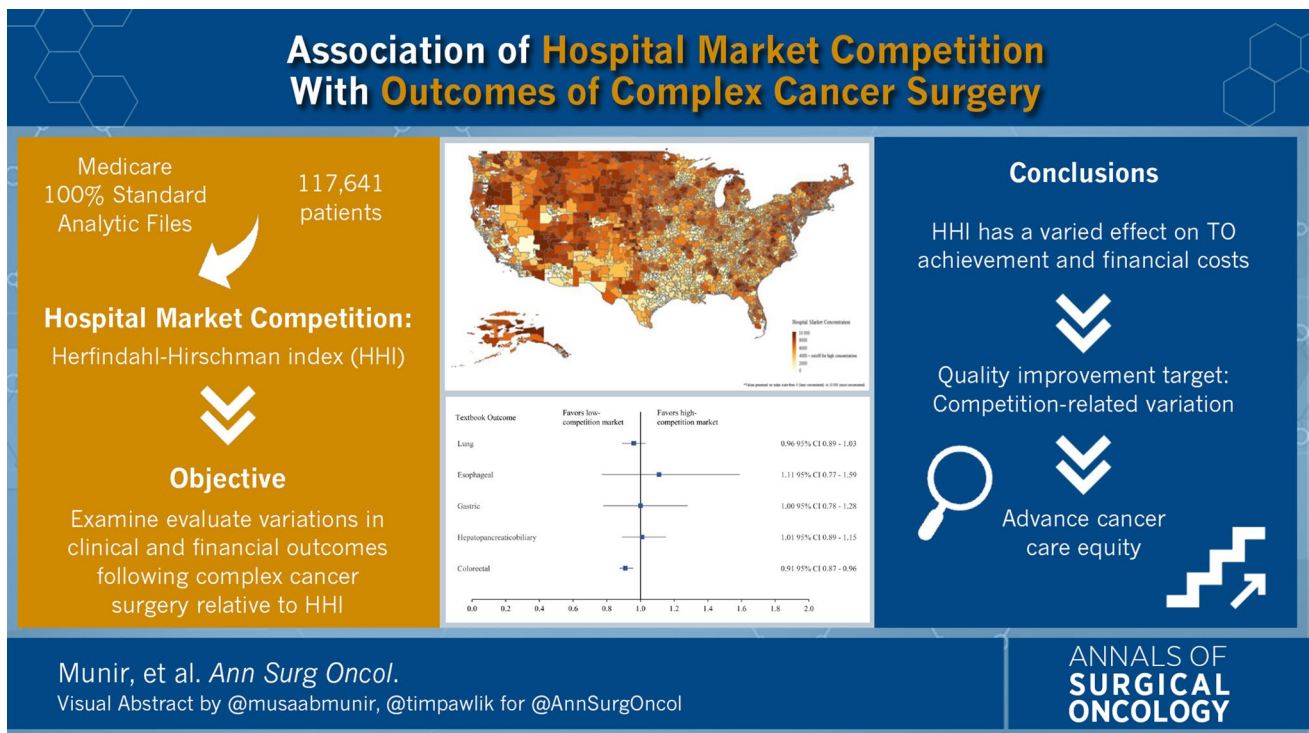
# ASO Visual Abstract: Association of Hospital Market Competition with Outcomes of Complex Cancer Surgery

The evolving landscape underscoring the relationship between hospital market competition, cost, and quality of high-risk surgical care is complex. In this study, hospital market competition was associated with surgical quality and cost of care after complex cancer surgery. There is a
