- GlaxoSmithKline has announced that it intends to donate 50 million doses of H5N1 adjuvanted prepandemic influenza vaccine to the WHO. These doses are sufficient to vaccinate 25 million people (2 injections per person), and are to be delivered over a 3-year period. GlaxoSmithKline made this move in response to the WHO's initiative to establish an international stockpile of H5N1 pre-pandemic vaccines.\* The company has also confirmed that it intends to make additional doses of its vaccine available to the WHO at preferential prices for GAVIeligible countries, and is prepared to make its adjuvant available for public purchase by governments.
