In Wraga et al. (2006), the work of Sharps, Price, and Williams (1994) and Sharps, Welton, and Price (1993) was characterized as being problematic for not including control groups. In fact, most of their studies did include control groups. However, these studies did not include explicit tests for within-gender effects on performance across experimental conditions. Therefore, it is not possible to conclusively determine the cause of the performance shifts. It should be noted that the general results reported by Sharps et al. were substantively in agreement with those reported in Wraga et al.
