

were initially determined with the first component of an experimental session being the component associated with the smaller response requirement (FR X). On the second determination, the first component of an experimental session was the component associated with the larger response requirement (FR Y). The close agreement between these two determinations suggests that which

component initiated an experimental session (FR X or FR Y) did not contribute importantly to the results.
